The problem

A tax team usually names one visible issue: research taking too long, or a documentation backlog. Underneath it sit the same connected issues: data that does not reconcile, documentation produced by hand and a control environment nobody can evidence live. Point solutions fix the visible issue and leave a new system that does not talk to the others.

What the Suite does

- TaxLex: AI-assisted tax research across 25 jurisdictions, cited to source.
- TaxMap: one account mapping, reused across tax reporting, tax return and Pillar Two data assembly.
- TaxTag: scalable templates for tax documentation, each entity's facts kept intact.
- TaxTrack: live dashboarding to manage and evidence every tax workflow.
- All four tools run as a SaaS solution or inside your own environment, with no licence fee for an in-house tax function (an advisory firm licensing the Suite for its own fee-earners is quoted a subscription in writing). Tax reporting, including Pillar Two reporting, is on the roadmap and is not available today.

The Suite is guided and built by people who have lived within the tax domain: the tools are the assets TIF delivers with, not the whole of what TIF delivers.
