The problem

The same general-ledger accounts get mapped by hand into a different shape for every tax process: one mapping for the VAT return, another for the CIT computation, another for Pillar Two data assembly. The mapping is rebuilt from scratch each cycle and drifts the moment the chart of accounts changes. None of that is tax analysis. It is account plumbing that repeats every filing cycle in every tax area.

What it delivers

- Maps source accounts (general ledger, trial balance, sub-ledgers) to the categories a given tax process needs.
- Area-agnostic: the same mapping engine applies to direct tax reporting, VAT reporting and any other area where accounts feed a tax output.
- Define a mapping once and reuse it across cycles, so the work is not rebuilt every close.
- One account mapping reused across tax reporting, tax return and Pillar Two data assembly, instead of a separate mapping rebuilt for each.
- Runs as a SaaS solution or inside your own environment, with no licence fee for an in-house tax function; an advisory firm licensing it for its own fee-earners is quoted a subscription in writing.

Works across tax areas from a single mapping: direct tax and VAT reporting from the same account structure.
